

SOPHIA HEWSON - BIO



Sophia is a multidisciplinary artist. She uses her body in her work. She uses her multi-generational psychological inheritance to explore wider issues such as contemporary sexuality, self-objectification, Western identity, and the experience of faithlessness.

Sophia completed a first class Honours Degree at the Victoria College of the Arts in 2007. Since then she has had several solo exhibitions including *Dy Dykrenore*, which featured a large scale ice sculpture with an imbedded kangaroo spine, and *Delivered* [internalising the pervert/or re-building the body psyche] where she hung for several hours covered in black glitter.

Sophia was selected by *Art Collector Magazine* as one of Australia's 50 most collectable artists. She has exhibited across Australia and internationally. Last year she was a recipient of the Northern Centre for Contemporary Art international project. This year she will complete a six month residency in New York at Residency Unlimited. Her preliminary research includes travelling to the Polygamous Mormon community of Hildale, interviewing street preachers, and meeting with pornography actors in Los Angeles.
