## **Art Critic | Jonathan Goodman (New York Art Critic)**

*“Lim is an artist who deals with seemingly simple pictures and emotions, but she is highly effective in making them stand for things larger than they are. In doing so, she is a true artist. Her work belongs to a new generation of Asian painters, whose work broaches timeless issues in seemingly guileless ways, but which actually is far more serious and even melancholic than the imagery seems at first glance. In a novel manner, Lim finds pathos in the midst of her child-like figures, who innocently enact the rituals of play in an attempt to offset the anxieties of human exchange. This at first seems eccentric, but to the artist’s credit, the work takes on greater, more serious sophistication over time. To her credit, her images memorably display some of the hardships of being human, with figures whose colorful details and simple vulnerabilities remain in our minds.”*
