She had 8 solo exhibitions in places for instance Gallery Aile (2017), Gallery 4walls (2016), Chungju Art Studio (2015), Alternative Space Noon (2014) and The K gallery (2011). She has also participated in many group exhibitions in Seoul, London, and Busan as well as many art fairs in Hong Kong, Seoul and Taiwan. She won the prize of 'Tomorrow's Artist' in Kyumjae-Jeongseon Art Museum in 2011 and she worked in Cheongju Art Residency as 8th artist in 2014.
