



Artist | Maker

I am a full time working visual artist and illustrator, who's art practice is currently focused on photographing the ephemeral artworks that are created by me, on an almost daily basis.

These artworks are made using only what is found on the ground and in the moment, using no tools and made regardless of weather, location or circumstance. They are left behind for others to experience (unless plastic).

I have photographed more than 500 artworks, 365 of these consecutively as a discipline challenge and they have been created, not only throughout Australia but in Shanghai and San Francisco.

These images inform other areas of my practice, as I now apply them to drawings, paintings and sculpture.

In 2015, I exhibited a portion of this project in London at the Kings Place Gallery by invitation and I was also invited to speak about the daily project, at a TEDx regional talk - "The Art of Saying Yes !"

In 2016 a larger number of these works were shown at various curated exhibitions including Art Est as a part of Art Monthly Sydney and at the Sydney Royal Botanical Gardens, Australia.

Most recently, I was awarded the Artist-in-Residence at Jacky Winter Gardens in Victoria, Australia, which was completed in November.
