Luo Chengzhi was born in 1972. He graduated from the Sculpture Department of China Central Academy Of Fine Arts in 1996. Having received a number of awards in various art exhibitions, he is now a professional sculptor with his own studio in Beijing, China.

In this exhibition, Luo has selected his works from two series created in the past ten years. Three works are from Water series because they have the same carrier - water. Beauty in Water symbolizes the artist's expectations of the future in the early years. At that time, he was helpless and longing for growth. This work uses the body of women to represent the budding state of a wandering life, implying the artist's hope for a growth. Once Upon a Time in Water shows the moment when the artist had a strong desire to step out of the complex and confusing world. He imagined that he himself once again went back to a newborn state. This idea pacified him. Love Lotus is about desire. Seed-case of lotus and women are two symbols to represent the artist's inner struggle to overcome the desire.

Wings of Light series was created around year 2010. These works reflect the desire of young individuals in searching for a recognition. This is maybe the monologue of every wanderer. They fantasize about growing their own wings and flying toward the light. A series of figures in various gestures have been created. They symbolize these young people with wings, who may have different attitudes towards life but they have never given up their own dream of flying.
